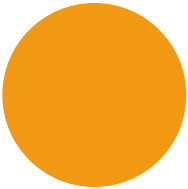

Mission & Ministry

WEEKLY COMMUNITY DINNER

Every Tuesday night, Fairview Christian Church hosts a community dinner, serving over 65 people a full meal. This ministry is made possible by the dedication of faithful volunteers who help prepare and serve the meals. The weekly dinner not only provides nourishment but also fosters a sense of community and fellowship among attendees.



EMERGENCY FOOD BANK

Recognizing that unexpected financial hardships can occur, Fairview Christian Church maintains an emergency food pantry. This service is available to families who find themselves in need of food, snacks, or meals when funds are low. To access this resource, families can call the church office to set up an appointment and receive an emergency food box, ensuring that no one in the community goes hungry during difficult times.

GROCERY GIVEAWAY

Following the closure of Fairview Methodist Church, which previously operated the only grocery pantry in Fairview Heights, Fairview Christian Church stepped up to continue this vital ministry. In collaboration with three other churches, Fairview Christian Church now hosts the grocery giveaway at their facilities. This partnership ensures that community members still have access to essential food resources.

HEALING ART STUDIO

Set to launch in 2025, the Healing Art Studio is an innovative ministry focused on supporting mental health through creative expression. This group currently meets once a month, with plans to expand in the future. Participants engage in various art and craft activities as a means of expressing emotions, followed by a sharing time. This ministry aims to provide a therapeutic outlet and foster emotional well-being through creativity.



CAMP MINISTRY

Fairview Christian Church is uniquely positioned with its own campground, affectionately known as "Church Farm." This facility allows the church to host summer day camps for community youth and children. Additionally, various groups utilize the campground throughout the year for different camping experiences, providing opportunities for spiritual growth and outdoor activities.





COLLEGE PARTNERSHIP

Fairview Christian Church has established partnerships with Virginia University of Lynchburg, Randolph College, and Sweet Briar College. These collaborations focus on spiritual life and internship opportunities for students. Additionally, Virginia University of Lynchburg provides student workers to support the church's ministries, creating a mutually beneficial relationship between the church and higher education institutions.

BASS ELEMENTARY PARTNERSHIP

The church is actively building a relationship with Bass Elementary School to support both staff and students. Volunteers from the congregation are involved in various supportive roles at the school. Furthermore, the church takes up special offerings to provide additional resources and assistance to the school community, strengthening the bond between the church and local education.

OPERATION CHRISTMAS BOX

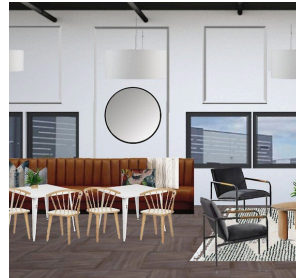

AUDIO/ VISUAL UPGRADES

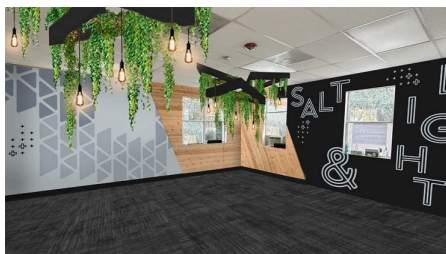

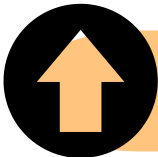
